# MHS Ranks Among Top 5 in Indiana

Munster High School was recently awarded Silver Medal status by U.S. News and World Report.

U.S. News recognized Munster High School as the fifth best public high school and the seventh best high school overall in the state. The rankings are based on the academic records of nearly 20,500 schools nationally.

Schools must meet a benchmark for graduation rate, demonstrate excellence in both English and Mathematics relative to their peers, and demonstrate that their students are prepared for college level coursework.

Munster High School's graduation rate of 97% and college readiness index of 47.9 propelled it to a national ranking as the 881st best school in the nation.

Speaking about the award, MHS principal Mike Wells had this to say, "Munster High School is proud of the partnership between our students, faculty, and parents. The fact that all three work toward the same common goal is why we are perennially in the top ten in the state."

# 10 National Merit Finalists

Munster High School is proud to announce that 10 students have recently qualified as finalists for the National Merit Scholarship program. The National Merit Scholarship is an academic competition, awarding scholarships to the nation's most promising students. In order to become a National Merit Scholarship Finalist, students must have an exemplary score on the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Qualifying Test.

# **Varsity Dance Team**

The Munster High School Varsity Dance Team ended the season with a 1st place finish in pom and 2nd place finish in jazz at the Indiana High School Dance Team Association state competition. The team consists of 16 members and is coached by Cindy Banas. The JV Team ended the season with a 1st place finish in pom and 2nd place finish in jazz.

# MHS Tops in Speech and Debate in the U.S.

The National Speech and Debate association named MHS one of the top 100 schools in the U.S. MHS ranked 56th out of more than 3,000 schools. Congratulations to program director Jordan Mayer and to all of the Munster High School Speech and Debate members for this remarkable honor.

Munster High School defeated over 90 high schools at the 2018 IHSFA State Speech Finals held at Fishers HS on March 10. MHS won the Class 2A State Championship and the Ralph Lawson Award, the overall team state championship. This is Munster's 9th consecutive state title and Munster High School's 17th title since 1968. MHS advanced 38 out of their 39 entries into the elimination rounds and set a state record. MHS advanced 21 entries into the State Final Round, the second most finalists ever on record. The state record of 23 finalists was set by Munster High School in 2013. Munster Speech and Debate was founded by Helen Engstrom in 1965. Munster Speech and Debate Alums include Emmy award winners, Ivy League Professors, United States Representatives, High School Teachers, and even a billionaire.

# MHSAA Highlights Coach Marsh's 38 Years of Accomplishments

Leroy Marsh has been the head coach at Munster High School for 38 years and was an assistant coach for seven years. He will continue to teach at Munster High School.
